

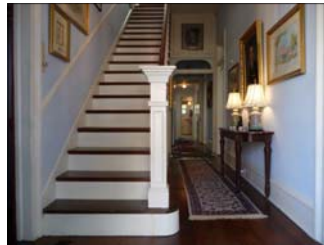


J. T. Moore House c.1893

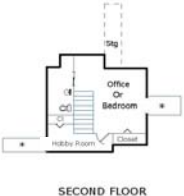

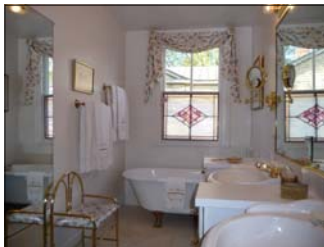


This elegant, renovated, Queen Anne-style cottage, with its long central hall, formal rooms and library, is a frequent Triangle gathering-place for musical, political and neighborhood groups. A southeast facing sunroom, wrap-around porch and deck overlook a big 0.29 acre lot with an expansive brick patio/parking area. Built in 1893 by J. T. Moore, a merchant and cotton broker, the home is an picturesque counter-point to the large Second Empire Marcellus Parker House next door. The library/family room has shutters, a handsome fireplace and wainscoting made from cut doors hung side-by-side. The now modern, eat-in kitchen was once detached, located in what today is the 2nd bedroom space, then joined to the house by a porch. The 1st floor Master bedroom has lots of storage high and low and an elegant bath. The upstairs 3rd bedroom, half bath and adjacent hobby room is a versatile space that could be an office, exercise space or playroom.



The Hobby Room is big enough for one or two single beds.

* Neat nooks with windows can be a hide-away for kids of all ages.
