



The multi-level deck outside the kitchen door is steps away from the long grass and gravel driveway leading to the small garage/workshop and potting studio.



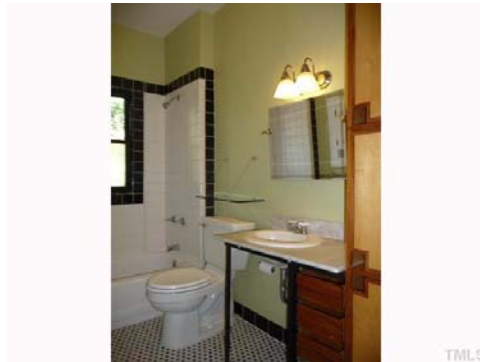
The back bedroom enjoys lots of light ...
